What is Jail Diversion?

Jail Diversion is comprehensive, residential, alcohol and substance abuse treatment as an alternative to jail.

Who can apply?

- Those offenders who have been convicted of or who have pending charges as a result of their addiction.
- Those offenders on probation who may have violated their terms of probation due to their addiction.
- Those offenders serving a jail sentence due to crimes related to their addiction.

What could deny my application?

- A sex offence conviction
- A true diagnosis of Schizophrenia, Schizoaffective Disorder or Bipolar with Psychosis (not diagnosed as a result of drug use)
- Current suicidal ideation
- A strong history of violence or harm to others
- A severe physical health issues that would interfere or disrupt the treatment process
- An unwillingness to recognize your addiction or need for help.
- Inability or unwillingness to refrain from prescription medication deemed inappropriate for residential treatment
- Being held by a court that denies a bond modification, a probation hold release, or an early sentence release.

What comes next?

Approval to release an offender from jail or instead of jail into residential treatment with The Counseling Center, Inc. must come from the court which is holding the offender.

The court is the ultimate authority.

Once the form is completed, deliver it to your Probation Officer, Judge, or Attorney and ask them to make a referral to The Counseling Center.

What does recovery look like?

A recovering person has accepted the realities of their disease and has taken personal responsibility for his or her life. Taking personal responsibility will involve not only abstinence, but also efforts to become a fully functioning, independent person who is working to heal broken relationships, addressing continuing emotional, health and spiritual issues, and using their experiences to help others. There are many, many people in long-term recovery who are making a significant contribution to their family, employer, church, and community.

The Counseling Center, Inc. is licensed by the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services, and has a national certification from CARF (Commission on the Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities). This assures The Counseling Center's programs are following certain best practices and standards, and is subject to regular reviews and audits.
